Andrew Hyde, founder of Startup Weekend, will speak at an event hosted by Lamp Post Group, River City, and The Enterprise Center about the importance of building a startup community. In addition to Startup Weekend, he founded Ignite Boulder and TEDxBoulder, and is a published author.

“Chattanooga’s first ever Startup Week was one of the biggest Startup Weeks in the country last year,” says Hyde. “I can’t wait to check it out this year and speak with the community about continuing to leverage the collaborative culture of the city and the thriving startup scene.”

SWC project manager, Stephanie Hays, hopes the experience inspires entrepreneurial thinking and showcases Chattanooga. “On the national scene, Chattanooga is a rising startup-hub,” Hays said. “This year we really want to build on last year’s success by helping to organize a week full of exciting, community-led events that really highlight what extraordinary things are happening here.”
